



WHAT IS THE BRIDGE RTO MAP ?

BRIDGE's Resource and Training Organisations (RTOs) map provides information on the size, scope, capacity and distribution of Early Childhood Development (ECD) Resource and Training Organisations across all nine provinces in South Africa. The map includes over 90 ECD RTOs thus far.

In this map you will find:

- the names and locations of the RTOs, as well as
- the contact details,
- implementing provinces,
- accreditation status and,
- ECD-specific training offered by each organisation.

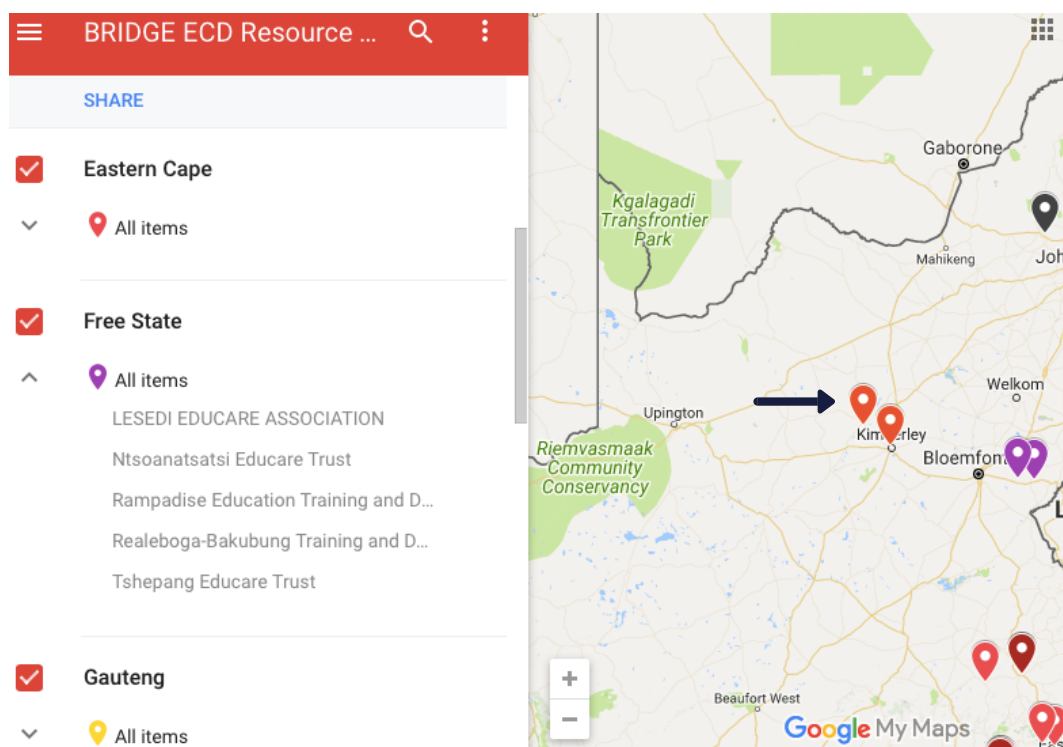
The RTO map is a useful resource for ECD practitioners seeking ECD-specific training.
