Early learning playgroups

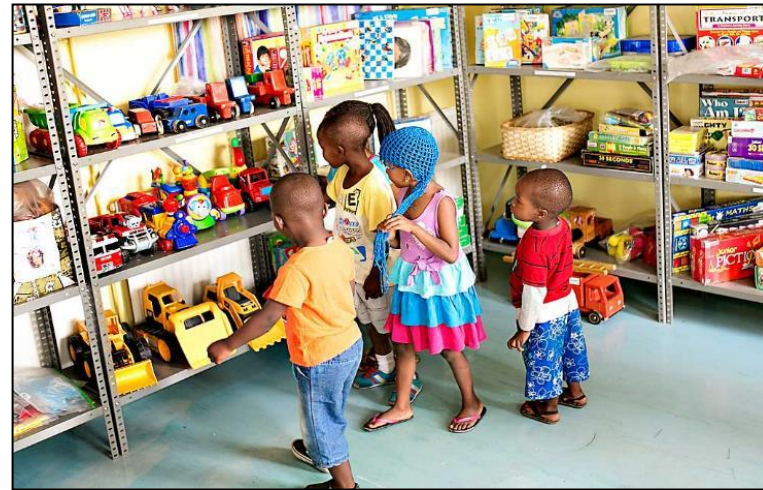
Early learning playgroup programmes are divided into playgroups for:
