The road travelled thus far

- ▶ Data collected from end of March 2020 to date;
- ▶ We sent out emails to social investors requesting them to participate by sharing financial and reach data on work done in response to COVID 19;
- ▶ Data is disaggregated according to specific interventions for instance PPE, food parcels, child protection, business rescue
- ▶ Internal clients also participated;
- ▶ All social investors signed a consent form;
- ▶ Data was exported to Power BI and mapped on SA map;
- ▶ R1.7 Billion mapped thus far

Key Lessons learned

- ▶ Data quality is key, ensure that you have clean data;
- ▶ The process is promoting accountability;
- ▶ Its showing efforts that social investors have put in response to COVID 19;
- ▶ The process has also allowed us to paint a beautiful picture and tell a South African story, its not just about people getting infected and affected, its about how Social Investors have responded to the pandemic;
- ▶ There are numerous opportunities to collaborate;
- ▶ Type of intervention should be specific, avoid “other” and request Social Investors to fill in the specific intervention
