### The current reality in SA

- 410,000 teachers employed in approximately 25,000 schools teaching 12.9 million pupils.
- 2. DBE has 10 000 unqualified and under-qualified teachers
- We need 25 000 new teachers per annum but currently, the country's ITE institutions graduate 15 000 new teachers per year.
- 4. Between 18,000 and 22,000 teachers leave the profession every year.



# Over 60% of new teachers in the system emerge from distance learning universities.



We need models that intentionally bridge the **gap** between theory and practice to enhance teaching quality.
